
PREFACE

This kit is required to adapt a 1980 (CS) thru 1990 (ES) *Evinrude®* and *Johnson®* 6, 7.5, and 8 HP outboard with remote steering.









1 Contents of Kit:

9	Steering Bracket	1 2
3	Locknut	2

In addition to this kit, you will need a Steering Connector Kit. If remote shift and throttle control are desired, order Remote Control Adapter Kit. A remote control and two control cables will be required in addition to the Remote Adapter Kit.

- Position steering bracket template (4) with center of template with center of rib (a), on bottom of steering bracket.
- 3 Center punch and drill holes using an 11/32 in. (9 mm) drill bit.
- Install steering bracket ① using two screws ② and locknuts ③. Tighten nuts to a torque of 120-140 in. lbs. (14-16 N·m).
