



Model 71060 Canoe Outboard Motor Bracket

MOUNTING INFORMATION

This bracket is designed to attach an outboard motor up to 3 h.p. on either the port or starboard side of most canoes. The canoe must have a gunwale with a lip that projects inward for clamps to operate properly.

MOUNTING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Place unit towards the rear of the canoe at the desired location resting the lip of motor mount casting (A) on the gunwale of one side of the canoe as shown.
2. Slide support sleeve (B) on the tube so it rests on the gunwale of the opposite side as illustrated.
3. Loosen both wing nuts (C). Slide clamp (D) under the inside lip of the gunwale while sliding eyebolt (E) at the same time. Repeat for the other side.
4. Align lip of motor mount casting (A) with gunwale by rotating support tube (F) to proper position.
5. Secure outboard motor bracket in position by tightening both wingnuts (C).
6. Periodically polish aluminum to extend longevity.
