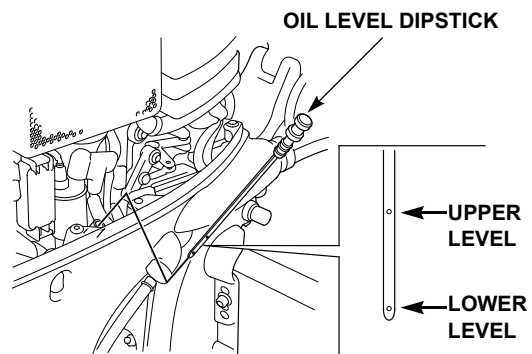



BF75/90D OIL CHECKING LOG

- Please perform the oil level checks in the same manner and the same position (trim angle, dock or trailer) each time. The best time to check the oil is before an outing.
- The level can be checked after the engine is operated, but you need to wait at least 15 minutes after shut-down before checking. Also when keeping the log, make sure the wait time between stopping the engine and checking the oil level, as well as the trim angle, is the same each time it is checked.
- Place the dipstick over the illustration below and make a mark showing the oil level. Label each mark with the date and number of hours on the engine.
- Measure the oil level enough times to show a definite increase (1/2-inch minimum). Contact your dealer for further instructions.
