





Housing Upper Gear

Kit No.'s

If this gear housing assembly is being used on Mechanical steering (Push-Pull Models), install as explained, but plug the worm gear bore as follows:

- 1. Install spacer shaft into worm gear bore. Spray threads of retainer with Locquic Primer. When dry, apply a small amount of Screw Lock™ to threads of retainer. Thread retainer into worm gear bore until it bottoms out on shaft and then back out 1/4 turn.
- 2. Install seal ring and o-ring in gear housing bore. See Figure 1.
- 3. Install bracket on rear of upper gear housing. Place lockwasher on each screw, install and tighten to a torque of 22-28 ft. lbs. (30-38 N·m).
- 4. In forward end, install bushing, small seal ring, washer and assemble retaining ring to shaft.

Note Failure to follow the above steps as described may result in damage to your gearcase.

Assembly For Push-Pull Mechanical Steering




When mounting the vertical drive to the intermediate housing, install the ground cable supplied as shown in Figure 2. Cable must be installed as shown to permit full tilt up and steering without applying tension to cable.
